Living arrangements at Brandenburg University of Applied Sciences

- Low cost of living in student dorm in Brandenburg an der Havel (from 195€ for a single room in a special unit to 270€ for a single apartment per month). On campus living subject to availability. These cost-effective apartments are available only to the students of the Brandenburg University of Applied Sciences.
- Special units: You will live in a single furnished room. Four rooms form one unit. Each unit contains a communal kitchen and sanitary facilities (shower, toilets, wash-basin). In the kitchen there is an electric cooker, a refrigerator with separate lockers (with keys), a kitchen table, chairs and a sink.
- Single apartments have their own kitchen (electric cooker, refrigerator) and bathroom.
- There are washing machines and dryers in the hall, which function with a chip card.
